Charging station

- Device status functionalities
- USB cable not included!
- Not suitable for settings programming
- Sales code: AFC
- When used with TWIG One Ex only cables of device types FME92EU, CME92EU or CCE92EU are allowed!

Multi-device charging station

- Simultaneous charging of 5 TWIG One/TWIG Easy/TWIG Neo devices
- Custom version for TWIG One Ex!
- Sales code: AFMA (AU), AFME (EU), AFMU (UK)
- Including charger with adapter of choice



Smart charging station

- The docked TWIG personal alarm device sends the serial number of the charging station to ARC.
- Optionally the docked TWIG device can be located with TWIG Point when smart charging station is geocoded to TWIG Point Site
- USB cable not included!
- Sales code: AFS
- When used with TWIG One Ex only cables of device types FME92EU, CME92EU or CCE92EU are allowed!



Programming station

- Device programming in upright position
- Full USB connectivity
- USB cable included
- Mount and remove using one hand only
- Sales code: AFP
- When used with TWIG One Ex only cables of device types FME92EU, CME92EU or CCE92EU are allowed!



Alterable SOS key colour

- DIY kit including 10 alert key tops in selected colour and 10 adhesive tapes
- Sales code: AFDB (black), AFDY (yellow) and AFDR (red) DIY kit
- Not included in standard sales package



Belt clip

- Belt clip is firmly fastened to device with screws, adhesive tape and brace
- Adhesive should be allowed to settle and dry before heavy use
- Allows 90 degree rotation
- Sales code: AFB
- Not included in standard sales package
- Not compatible with TWIG Neo



Carrying case

- Leather case with transparent front and simple to use swivel belt clip mechanism to use either vertical or horizontal position.
- Ideal with ManDown alert systems.
- Sales code for TWIG One/TWIG Easy carrying case: AFO
- Sales code for TWIG One Ex carrying case: AFX
- Not included in standard sales package



Mains charger

- Included in the standard sales package
- Sales code: ACM-A (AU), ACM-E (EU), ACM-U (UK)



Charging Adapter

- Adapter to connect the mini-USB cable to device
- Works for charging and programming
- Sales code: AFA (black), AXA (yellow for ATEX devices)
- Included in standard sales package




Ex charger

- Ex charger (CME92EU) to be used for charging TWIG One Ex
- Sales code: ACE-A (AU), ACE-E (EU), ACE-U (UK)
- TWIG One Ex and TWIG Neo Ex devices must not be connected to any charger with any other cable than FME92EU, CME92EU or CCE92EU.
- Included in TWIG One Ex and TWIG Neo Ex sales packages



Worn with lanyard and ripcord

- TWIG Neo worn with lanyard and ripcord is easy to carry and quick to reach
- Lanyard is equipped with magnet launching rip alarm when detached from device
- Rip alarm is available only with TWIG Neo equipped with lanyard and ripcord magnet
- Sales code: AWP
- Optional ID badge holder extends device use for front office and social and health care staff
- Sales code: AWF1

- TWIG Neo worn on wrist is your safety watch always at hand
